Motion by Director O'Day, Seconded by Director Goolsby to table any action regarding the permit applications for the two lake wells at Twin Lakes Club pending the receipt of additional information for penalty calculation and meter installation. Motion approved with all present voting aye.

Motion by Director Felder; Seconded by Director Mueller that the Board **OPEN** a public hearing regarding applications for permits received.

Motion by Director Mueller; Seconded by Director O'Day to approve the permit for the lake fill well in Item 2 contingent upon the installation of an approved meter. Motion approved with all present voting aye.

Motion by Director; Seconded by Director Pyburn to approve the permits for the remaining two wells in Item 2 serving restrooms and a fish cleaning station contingent upon installation of meters on the lines providing water for those facilities. Motion approved with Directors Pyburn, Felder, O'Day and Goolsby voting aye; Director Mueller voted no.

Motion by Director O'Day; Seconded by Director Pyburn that Item 4 be approved contingent upon payment in full of past years' fees due for the existing non-exempt well on the site that was replaced and was not permitted with the District. Motion approved with all present voting aye.

Motion by Director Felder; Seconded by Director Pyburn to waive the \$250.00 penalty assessed to the owner for failure to permit the well prior to drilling and approve Item 7 with the following conditions:

- Well is approved as a Commercial use well and is not to be operated as a public water supply well until owner provides documentation from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality stating the well meets public water supply standards; and
- Well is equipped with a meter meeting District standards
